### Vacation Bible School Report

We averaged 50 students each day (starting with 41 on Monday and reaching a high of 56 on both Thursday and Friday). We were able to have an influence on a total of 65 different students.

The staff averaged 20 adults and 5 teens each day (that's about a 2:1 ratio of students to staff – lots of personal attention). Thank you to those faithful, selfless workers who ministered to the students this past week!

Our offering this year is going to Alan & Katherine Niles (ABWE to Togo, West Africa). They are setting up a way for widows or unsupported wives to start a business and earn an income. It involves filling bags of water, freezing them, and then going around and selling them (a desirable product in hot Africa). Our offering will finance the purchase of a freezer and coolers for the women to carry the water. The goal was \$500 to purchase a freezer and some coolers. Our offering came to a total of \$881.37! Bless the Lord!
